


Mullin ProCross



There are currently 67 milking cows on an A5 Lely robot with an additional 13 dry cows making up the Mullin ProCross herd

At the heart of this strategy is the sequential use of Holstein, Montbéliarde and Danish Red genetics. As illustrated in the graph below, the Lactation curve differs from that of the traditional Holstein breed with its elongated and flatter shape.

Health issues:

- Culling: 1 cow culled for poor performance
- Mastitis: No significant issues,
 Lactation 2 average SCC 39 and TBC
 5.
- Injuries: 1 cow suffered a broken shoulder.
- Calving: Very limited intervention, calves show high levels of vigour, up and suckling within an hour.
- Lameness: Treated 6 cases for feet over the past 2 years, general foot health good.
- Fertility: Cows have an average fertility rate of 358 days to lactation 2.
